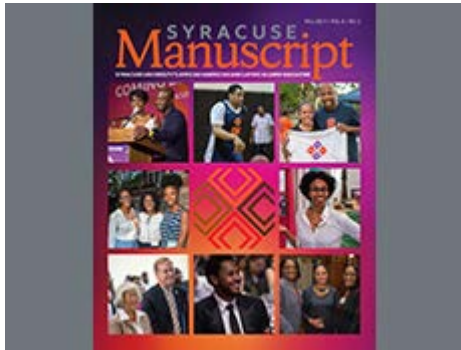


A certified public accountant from Atlanta, Houston gave to the accounting endowed scholarship because she believes investing in education has the potential to reap a multigenerational return.
